Hammond Levi Marsh, '82, died recently at his home in Wienita, Kans., in his 87th year.

Surviving are his widow, three sons, and two daughters. Funeral services were held in Lakey chapel, the Rev. F. Q. Davidson of the Fairmount Congregational church officiating, Burial was in Memorial

He had lived in Wichita since 1909, having taught school and served in the ministry.
