## Funeral Services Here Today For Mary Marshall, 78

Mrs. Mary Marshall, 78, of 1403 Third Ave., died Friday morning at a local hospital.

Funeral services were held this afternoon (Monday) from the James-Schalinske Funeral Home with the Rev. Donald Rich, pastor of the Assembly of God church, officiating. Organ music was provided by Mrs. Kathleen Heffner.
