Mrs. Julia M. Marvin, 80, of Sacramento, Calif., a former Grinnell resident, died Saturday at Sacramento.

Funeral services will be held at 10 a.m. Tuesday from the Smith Funeral Home here with the Rev. Ralph Beebe of the Mayflower Home officiating. Organ music will be provided by Mrs. Rhee Auman.

She was born August 4, 1884, at Spencer, Iowa, the daughter of James W. and Alice A. Robison. She received her education in the Spencer and Grinnell schools and later was united in marriage with Wilbur F. Marvin.

Her husband preceded her in death in 1940.
