man dies in blaze

A Victor man died Tuesday when fire swept through his two-story frame home.

Authorities said Joe Maschmann, 28, died of smoke inhalation. His body was found in a bedroom of the home. The blaze apparently was ignited by a smoldering cigarette in a chair *Aug. 21*

Funeral services are scheduled for 10:30 a.m. Saturday at St. James Lutheran Church in Victor. Burial will be at the Odd Fellows Cemetery there.

A 1968 graduate of HLV High School, Maschmann was employed by the Jim Smith Construction Co. of Victor.

He is survived by his parents, Mr. and Mrs. Ray Maschmann of rural Hartwick; one sister, Caroline of Cherokee; a brother, Steve of the U.S. Army stationed in Germany; and his paternal grandmother, Mrs. Hertha Maschmann of Victor.
