**Jack Mason rites Tuesday**

Jack L. Mason, 69, of Rte. 2, Kellogg, died of a heart attack Friday morning, Jan. 6, at the Wiltfang-Paulson Clinic.

Funeral services will be conducted at 1 p.m. Tuesday at the Smith Funeral Home, with burial in Newton Memorial Garden Cemetery.

The son of Charles and Cornelia (Albert) Mason, he was born Aug. 13, 1914, in Grinnell. He graduated from Grinnell High School and attended the University of Northern Iowa and U.C.L.A., where he played football.
