Rex E. Massengale, 51, of Colorado Springs, Colo., formerly of Grinnell, died of cancer Thursday, Sept. 9, at his home.

Funeral services were conducted Sept. 13 at the Pulpit Rock Baptist Church in Colorado Springs, with the Rev. Tim Cox officiating. Burial was in the Shrine of Remembrance, Colorado Springs.
