

David Matlack memorial set

David J. Matlack, 80, of the Mayflower Home died Saturday morning, April 6, at the Mayflower Home Health Care Center.

A memorial service will be conducted at 10 a.m. Saturday, April 13, in Dennison Chapel of Kiesel Hall, the Mayflower Home. Mr. Matlack's body was donated to the University of Iowa College of Medicine.

The son of Henry and Merta Johnson Matlack, he was born July 31, 1904, at Chicago, Ill. The family moved to Grinnell
