Leon Maulik, youngest son of Anna and Gottlieb Maulik, was born near Posen in East Germany on March 25, 1861, and departed this life at a Grinnell hospital early Tuesday morning, Sept. 1, at the advanced age of 78 years, five months, and six days.

He came to the United States with his parents in 1877, and settled near Victor, Iowa, where he spent most of his life engaged in farming until his retirement to Grinnell in 1929. He has resided in Poweshiek county over 75 years.

On November 13, 1896, he was married to Rose Dusterhoff of Ladora, Iowa, and to this union three daughters were born.

He is survived by two daughters, who have cared for him in his home for the last 15½ years. He was preceded in death by his wife, who passed away in 1944, an infant daughter, his parents, two sisters, and two brothers.

Memorial services were held on Thursday, Sept. 3, at 2 p.m., at the McAninch Funeral Home at Victor. Rev. Leland Mann of Grinnell was in charge of the services. Interment was in the I.O.O.F. cemetery at Victor.
