

MEAD, Rev. Enoch, d. at Davenport Dec. 6, 1892, aged 83, a grandson of Gen. Mead of the Revolution, and his father's farm in Connecticut contained the flight of stone steps down which Gen. Israel Putnam went headlong to escape the British cavalry. He came to Iowa in 1837, a pioneer teacher and preacher. Leaves a wife and son and daughter, the wife a sister of J. K. James and cousin of R. M. Kellogg. He was a classmate at Yale of Rev. T. G. Brainard of this city. Ob.
