Rites held for Mr. Meredith

Funeral services for Jesse Meredith, 77, of Brooklyn, who died Wednesday, March 5, at Grinnell General Hospital, were held Saturday at the Nevenhoven Funeral Home in Brooklyn.

The Rev. Fred P. Pierce, pastor of the Grace United Methodist Church, officiated, with burial at the I.O.O.F. Cemetery.

The son of Harvey and Phoebe Hester Starr Meredith, he was born May 4, 1897, in Koesauqua. He recieved his education in Victor, moving to Brooklyn in 1929. Mr. Meredith operated a milk route as a young man and later worked for Maytag in Newton and Colins Radio in Cedar Rapids. In recent years, prior to his retirement, he was a custodian at the Brooklyn Post Office. He was also engaged in farming.
