CHARLES E. MILBURN.

The funeral of Charles E. Milburn who died at his home in north Sheridan township after a brief illness of two days, was held at the Methodist church at Malcom at half past one Sunday, in charge of the I. O. O. F. lodge of which he was a faithful and honored member. Rev. D. Phillips assisted at the services.

The deceased was a young man, just on the threshold of a successful life, having been born in Martineau county, Mo., May 5, 1883. He came to this county in 1901 and has made his home with his brother, J. M. Milburn. At the time of his death they were farming the old H. L. Rhodes farm in Sheridan.

He was highly respected by those who knew him and was a young man of kindly nature and good character. His remains were sent to his old home in Barnett, Missouri, for burial being accompanied by his brother, Thomas Milburn who came here for the funeral.
