## Elsie E. Mill Rites Conducted

Elsie E. Mill, 76, a resident of the Mayflower Home, died Thursday evening at Grinnell General Hospital, following a brief illness.

She was born Sept. 16, 1893, on a farm five miles north of Benson, Minn. When she was five, her parents moved to Benson, and she attended the public schools of that community. After graduation, she completed a stenographic course at St. Cloud (Minn.) Business College.

On Dec. 21, 1913, she married Harry L. Mill at Sioux Falls, S. D. In 1925, they moved to Nebraska and for 24 years lived in Omaha. Since 1954, they have lived at the Mayflower Home.

Mrs. Mill is survived by her husband; five children, Harry W. Mill of Grinnell, Beatrice Newell of Omaha, Dr. Cyril Mill of Washington, D.C., Jack L. Mill of Los Angeles, and Dean E. Mill of Richland, Wash.; nine grandchildren and 11 great-grandchildren.

Funeral services for Mrs. Mill were conducted at 10 a.m. Saturday at the Denison Chapel, Mayflower Home, with the Rev. Ralph Beebe officiating. Pianist was Ruth Campbell, and interment was in the Forest Lawn Cemetery at Omaha.
