

**August Miller, 88,  
Kellogg, Succumbs;  
Funeral Saturday**

August Miller, 88, Kellogg, died Wednesday at a local hospital. He had been in ill health for the past two years.

Funeral services were held on Saturday afternoon at a Marshalltown funeral home with the Rev. Nelson Murdock, pastor of Center Friends church, officiating. Interment was in Timber Creek cemetery.

Son of August and Ann Butchaw Miller, he was born Dec. 23, 1870, in Scott county, and moved with his parents while an infant to a farm six miles north of Kellogg. He resided there for 35 years.

Mr. Miller was married to Laura Speas on Nov. 10, 1903, and she died in 1949. Also preceding him in death were two sons, Sgt. Oliver, who was killed in action during World War II, and Floyd; two daughters, Karen and Florence, who died in infancy.

He is survived by three sons, Maurice of Glasgow, Mont., Virgil of Kellogg, Marion of Ames; and one daughter, Mrs. Bill Williams of Marshalltown. Other survivors include nine grandchildren, three great grandchildren, and several nieces and nephews.
