

## Calvin Miller

Calvin Miller, 78, died Thursday, June 16, at the Montezuma Senior Home.

Funeral services were conducted June 18 at Watts Funeral Home in Montezuma, with the Rev. Brian Carter officiating. Organist was Alice Underwood.
