**Mrs. Eliza Miller Passes Away at
Home of Daughter in Lynnvile.**

Eliza Jane Reynolds Miller was born in Morgan County, Indiana, November 26, 1845 and departed this life at the home of her daughter, Mrs. Fred Beason in Lynnvile, Iowa, September 12, 1924 at the advanced age of 78 years, 10 months, and 17 days. At the age of two years she came with her parents, Alfred and Marian Reynolds, to Sugar Creek Township, Poweshiek County, Iowa. At the age of 20, Aug. 1865, she was united in marriage with Enoch Miller, he having preceded her to the better world in July 1900. To this union were born eight children, four of whom

are still living to mourn the loss of a loving mother. They are Mrs. Fred Beason of Lynnvile, Mrs. Mattie Cooper and Mrs. Nettie Conger, both of Grinnell, and Mrs. Dora McDonald of Gridley, California. She first united with The Little Mount Baptist Church and was immersed in baptism at the early age of fourteen years, afterwards uniting with the West Liberty Church of Christ of which she was a faithful member until death claimed her.
