Faye Miller dies at 97

Faye Wilson Miller, 97, formerly of the Mayflower Home, died suddenly at her home in Green Valley, Ariz., on Dec. 8, friends here have learned.

Following cremation, her ashes were buried at Ennis, Mont.

She was born in March 1882 in Green Valley, where she received her early education. She received her degree in home economics from Iowa

State University in 1915. She married Guy O. Miller in 1918, and they lived briefly in Great Falls, Mont., in Chile and Argentina for five years, for a short time in California, and finally in Barlesville, Okla.

When Mr. Miller retired they built a home at Lake of the Ozarks, Mo. After Mr. Miller died, she came to the Mayflower Home in 1965. She moved to Arizona in 1975.
