## Glenn E. Miller Dies At Newton

A former Grinnell resident, Glenn E. Miller, 44, of Newton, died Friday afternoon at his home there.

Funeral services will be held at 10 a.m. Tuesday at the First Assembly of God church in Newton with the Rev. Hilton Griswold officiating. Burial will be in Newton Union cemetery.

The son of Vernon and Ida Grovenburg Miller, he was born Jan. 31st, 1922, at Grinnell and attended the Grinnell schools. On July 13th, 1946, he was united in marriage with Pearl Wilcox at Newton.

Mr. Miller had been engaged in the trucking business.

Survivors include his wife, Pearl; a daughter, LaVina Cupples; and one granddaughter.

Also surviving are eight brothers, Walter of Prairie City, Harold of Marshalltown, Raymond in the armed forces, Harry of Grinnell, Adrian of El Paso, Tex., Donald of Chicago, Gerald of Luzerne, Richard of Prairie City, and Larry Gene of Grinnell; and two sisters, Mrs. Verna Taylor of Marshalltown and Mrs. Audrey Tyer of Winterset.

He was preceded in death by his parents.
