JOHN BENJAMIN MILLER

John Benjamin Miller was born at Harrisonburg, Virginia, June 25, 1871 and died at the St. Francis hospital in Grinnell, July 6, 1938, at the age of 67 years and 11 days. He had been in ill health for several years and the past few months declined rapidly.

When a small child, his parents, the late Mr. and Mrs. Thompson Miller came to Poweshiek county, Iowa. This has been John's residence for the greater part of his life. Retiring from the farm 14 years ago, he has resided in Brooklyn with his sister, Grace Miller.

John Miller was known for his honesty, and integrity. He was a man of few words and was respected by his many friends and acquaintances. Many years ago, he became a mem-

ber of the Madison Church and this was the affiliation until his death.

Surviving are his brothers Jesse and Ira, and sister Grace, numerous other relatives and friends.

Funeral services were held at the Bramer Funeral Home in Brooklyn, on Tuesday, July 8th at 2 p.m. The officiating minister was Stephen J. Epler of Grinnell, a long time friend of the family. The interment was in the Odd Fellows cemetery in Brooklyn.
