Mr. Milligan services held

McKinley Milligan, 75, of Montezuma, died Nov. 10 at St. Luke's Hospital in Cedar Rapids.

Funeral services were held Nov. 15 at the Steffy Funeral Home. Burial was at Our Silent City Cemetery, Kellogg.

He was born March 12, 1901, near Grinnell. He attended school in Kellogg.
