## Mrs. Mitchell Dies; Services Tuesday

Mrs. Hannah M. Mitchell, 77, widow of Louis A. Mitchell, died Sunday morning (Oct. 18) at the Lone Elm Nursing Home in Grinnell.

The daughter of Lafayette and Nancy See Tennant, Mrs. Mitchell was born in Clarke County, Iowa, on Jan. 2, 1893. When she was three years old her parents moved to the Grinnell area, and she has continued to make her home in Grinnell the past 74 years.

On Jan. 1, 1910, she was married to Louis A. Mitchell. Seven children were born to this union.

Survivors include four of her seven children—Mrs. Lester (Viola) Holcomb, Mrs. Cecil Vaughn and George Mitchell of Grinnell and Mrs. Bernard (Dorothy) Matherly of Pella; 18 grandchildren; 29 great grandchildren; and one sister, Jennie See of Grinnell.

Mrs. Mitchell was preceded in death by her husband, Louis, in 1933; three children—Garland in 1916, Gail in 1929 and Clifford in 1930; two great-grandchildren; and three sisters and one brother—Mary Marshall, Bessie Belcher, Lulu Baysinger and George Tennant.

Funeral services for Mrs. Mitchell will be held at 1:30 p.m. Tuesday (Oct. 20) at the Smith Funeral Home.

The Rev. Newell E. Davis, pastor of the United Church of Christ-Congregational, will officiate. Organist will be Mrs. Willard Heffner.
