Isobel Mithelman Dies Thursday; Services Today

Mrs. Isobel Mithelman, of 1420 Fourth Avenue, died Thursday afternoon at a local hospital where she had been a patient for the past five weeks.

Funeral services for Mrs. Mithelman were conducted this afternoon from the James-Schallinske Funeral Home with the Rev. L. H. Streich of St. John's Lutheran church officiating. Organ music was provided by Mrs. Kathleen Herfner.

Palbearers were Howard Edwards, Russell George, Ross Courts, Clair Strand, Al Pinder, and Raymond Norris. Interment was at Hazelwood cemetery.

Mrs. Mithelman was born in Belfast, Ireland, and in 1908 came to the United States. For the past 59 years she was employed by the Grinnell Herald-Register. She retired only last September.

She was married to August W. Mithelman, who preceded her in death on Oct. 13, 1945.

Mrs. Mithelman is survived by one brother living in Ireland; a sister-in-law, Mrs. Rosa Hotchkin of Grinnell; and a brother-in-law, Herman Mithelman of Wever, Iowa.
