Max Moberly, 66, Lifetime Resident Of Kellogg, Dies

Max Moberly, 66, Kellogg hardware store operator and a lifelong resident of that community, died Monday night at a Des Moines hospital.

Funeral services were held this afternoon (Thursday) from the Kellogg Christian church with the Rev. Herbert Miller, pastor, officiating. Burial was in Our Silent City cemetery at Kellogg.

The son of Charles and Lydia Miller Moberly, he was born on Sept. 20, 1897, at Kellogg. He was married to Helen Louise Edwards, who preceded him in death on Sept. 8, 1963.

During World War I he served in the U.S. Navy. He was a member of the Kellogg Christian church and the American Legion.

Survivors include a son, Dick, of Des Moines; two grandchildren; a niece and a nephew.
