JOHN MOLINE DIES SUDDENLY AT AGE OF 68

Jan 3 1929. Was Stone Cutter Of Rare Skill and Ability

Funeral services of John Moline, for many years a resident of Grinnell, were held at 2:30 o'clock this afternoon from the Suyder Funeral chapel, with Rev. George Blagg officiating. Interment was in Hazelwood cemetery.

Mr. Moline died suddenly at 7:30 o'clock Thursday evening, at his home on South Main street, at the age of 68 years. He was born in Solan, sweden in 1860, and came to this country about 25 years ago.
