OF MRS. W. G. MYERS

Anna J. Conrad, daughter of John Conrad and his wife Marie nee Schaffer, was born at Sterling, Illinois on January 31, 1878.

In early infancy she was brought to God in holy baptism and in early youth was instructed and confirmed in the Luthern faith.

In 1904 she was united in marriage with W. G. Myers, and to this union one child was born. Mrs. Lawrence Squires at 823 Prince street. For a number of years Mrs. Myers resided at Chicago, Illinois before coming to Grinnell where she spent the rest of her life.
