Beulah Malloy, 81, of 728
5th St., Grinnell, died
Thursday morning at the Lone
Elm Nursing Home, following
an extended illness.

The daughter of Peter and
Elizabeth Head Doud, she was

Grinnell and received her
education in the rural schools
of that community.
