Obituary.

Estella Merrihew was born April 18, 1869, on a farm near Bowling Green, Ohio, and passed away in Montezuma, Iowa, on February 5, 1952, at the age of 82 years, 9 months and 18 days. Her father, Fred Merrihew, was an early day Methodist minister who later turned to farming.

In Montezuma, in 1902, she was united in marriage to Frank Moore. They moved to Kansas and then to western Oklahoma. Their home in Oklahoma was destroyed by fire in 1917 and they returned to Montezuma, where they resided until Mr. Moore's death in 1927.

Mrs. Moore was preceded in death by her husband and one son, George, whose death was caused by the flu epidemic during World War I. She is survived by one son, Homer, of Laurel, Iowa, three grandsons, and two great-grandchildren.
