GEORGE LOUIS MORGAN.

George Louis Morgan, son of John Morgan and his wife, Mary DuBois, was born near Kellogg, Ia., Sept. 26, 1879. He spent almost his entire life on the farm.

The deceased studied law at Drake university in Des Moines and was later admitted to the bar in the state of Missouri.

He was united in marriage to Edna Patton on Dec. 22, 1926. Two sons were born to this union: James, of Pittsburg, and John, of Chicago. Mr. Morgan left the farm about five years ago because of ill health. He had been hospitalized for more than two years, and passed away at a Grinnell hospital Thursday afternoon. He was preceded in death by his parents, three brothers: Will, Vester and Fred.

He is survived by his devoted wife, his two sons, one brother, H. W. Morgan, of Lewton; and a sister, Mrs. Emma Robison, of Nevada; also many nieces, nephews and a host of friends.

The deceased had reached the advanced age of 78 years, 9 months and 23 days.
