

Pioneer of Rock Creek Is Dead

Funeral services for Mrs. Mary M. Morgan, one of the early residents of Poweshiek county, were held Saturday, Dec. 29 in the Kellogg Methodist church, conducted by Rev. Robert Lee Stuart of Newton. Mrs. Morgan died the Thursday preceding in the Skiff Memorial Hospital in Newton, aged 82 years.

Mrs. Morgan before her marriage was Mary M. Dubois and was born in Scott County, Oct. 1, 1864. She was married to John Morgan in 1867 and came to Jasper county with her husband in 1870, settling on a farm in Rock Creek township where they made their home until Mr. Morgan's death in September, 1907.

To Mr. and Mrs. Morgan nine children were born, eight sons and one daughter. Three sons died in infancy. She is survived by one daughter, Mrs. W. J. Robinson of Newton, and five sons, W. R. Morgan, V. H. Morgan, G. L. Morgan and H. L. Morgan, all of Newton and C. V. Morgan of Kellogg.

Following her husband's death Mrs. Morgan moved to Kellogg where she lived until two years ago when she went to Newton to live with her daughter and son, G. L. Morgan.
