Rites held for Mr. Morrison

C. R. "Bud" Morrison, 71, of Malcom died of a heart attack Sunday, Dec. 22, at his farm.

Funeral services were conducted at 1:30 p.m. Thursday at St. John's Lutheran Church south of Victor, with the Rev. Kenneth Bartelt, pastor of the church, officiating. Organist was Marna Mohr, and pallbearers were Lyle Bauman Sr., Deane Casey, Floyd Doty, Kenneth McMains, Barney McDowell, Ross Mintle, Walter Puls and Glenn Urter.

Burial was in St. John's Lutheran Cemetery near Victor, with the Smith Funeral Home of Grinnell in charge of arrangements. Memorials in Mr. Morrison's name may be made to the church.

The son of Ruben and Neta Campbell Morrison, he was born on March 12, 1914, at Mount Pleasant. The family later lived in the Deep River and Malcom areas, and he attended Poweshiek County schools.

On May 1, 1937, he was married to Agnes Timm at Nashua. Following their marriage, they lived in Malcom where Mr. Morrison delivered petroleum products for the Midway Oil Co. of Rock Island, Ill. He also delivered lime and farmed near Malcom.

He was a member of St. John's Lutheran Church of rural Victor. He was a past member of the Malcom City Council and the Malcom Volunteer Fire Department.

Survivors include his wife, Agnes; his daughter, Mary Schultz of rural Malcom; six grandchildren; four sisters, Mildred Johnston and Cleo Christenson, both of Los Angeles, Calif.; Esther Howard of Pulaski and Dorothy Timm of Ladora; and one brother, James Morrison of Pulaski. He was preceded in death by his parents; one son, Paul Ray Morrison; a brother, Billie Dale Morrison; and one sister, Mary Grier.
