Clare Robert Morrison, son of Robert G. and Effie E. Wagner Morrison was born on a farm northwest of Deep River, April 11, 1913 and passed away at Grinnell hospital Nov. 1 at the age of 72 years, 6 months and 18 days.

He attended school and church in the Guernsey community. Clare farmed in the Guernsey and Deep River communities for many years and served in WW II for two years.
