

Mrs. Carrie L. Morse Passes

We have received an obituary of Mrs. Carrie L. Jones Morse, who died in Pasadena, Jan. 24, at the age of 75 years. Mrs. Morse was well known here till a few years ago. Her son was for several years one of the carrier boys on The Herald and some of The Herald subscribers will remember him. She was a woman of upright character, a student at one time in Grinnell college and a woman of rare integrity.

Her daughter furnishes the following obituary:

Mrs. Carrie L. Morse, widow of F. P. Morse, formerly of Grinnell, Iowa, died at her late residence, 397 South Chester Avenue, Pasadena, Calif., Sunday, Jan. 24, 1932, at the age of 75 years.

Mrs. Morse was born at Jefferson, Ohio, in 1856, and moved to Grinnell at an early age with her parents, Mr. and Mrs. P. V. Jones. She married Franklin Pierce Morse who passed away in Pasadena, Calif., July, 1913. They are survived by their seven children who were all born at or near Grinnell: Mrs. Cora Williamson of Gilman, Iowa; Mrs. Kate Nicholson of Santa Maria, Calif.; Virgil F. Morse of Pacoima, Calif.; Mrs. Fannie Phillips and Howard N. Morse of Eugene, Ore.; Arthur E. Morse and Miss Louise Morse of Pasadena, Calif.

Mrs. Morse is also survived by six brothers: Prof. Marcus Jones, Claremont, Calif.; Edward Jones and Lute Jones of Pasadena, Calif.; Rev. Burton Jones of Newberg, Ore.; Dr. Lynds Jones of Oberlin, Ohio, and Dr. Arthur Jones of Swarthmore, Pa. Another brother, Charles Jones, passed away several years ago at Grinnell.

She is also survived by 24 grandchildren and four great grandchildren.

With Mrs. Morse at the time of her death were her daughters, Mrs. Kate Nicholson and Miss Louise Morse; her daughter-in-law, Mrs. Arthur Morse; and her brother and wife, Dr. and Mrs. Lynds Jones of Oberlin, Ohio. Mrs. Cora Williamson, her eldest daughter of Gilman, Iowa, and Prof. Marcus Jones, her eldest brother, were in Pasadena to attend the funeral services, as were also William E. Williamson, a grandson, formerly of Gilman, now of Hollywood, Calif., and Miss Grace M. Burton, a cousin, daughter of the late P. D. Burton of Grinnell, now residing in Los Angeles, Calif.

Among the pallbearers were the Messrs. J. T. Cessna, N. W. Cessna and Leo E. Carson, all former residents of Grinnell.

Mrs. Morse was a niece of the late Theodore E. Burton and his brother, P. D. Burton, and a cousin of Arthur Burton, present postmaster of Grinnell. Her passing will be mourned by her many friends in Grinnell.
