Russel L. Mott, 62, of Grinnell died of an apparent heart attack Saturday morning, Feb. 15, at Grinnell General Hospital.

Funeral services will be conducted at 10 a.m. Tuesday at the Smith Funeral Home, with the Rev. Sam Reaves, pastor of the Grinnell Assembly of God Church, officiating. Masonic rites were at 7 p.m. Monday at the funeral home.

Burial will be in Hazelwood Cemetery, with military rites performed by the Grinnell Veterans Ceremonial Unit. A Russ Mott Memorial Fund has been established, and contributions may be sent in care of the funeral home.

The son of J. Leonard and Blanche Bever Mott, he was born on Feb. 25, 1923, in Des Moines. He attended Des Moines schools and North High School and graduated from Drake University in 1949.

He was married to Dolores G. Brower on June 4, 1949, in Des Moines. The couple came to Grinnell in 1956. Mr. Mott was manager of Grinnell Thermogas until 1970, the owner of Mott's Home Specialty Store until 1972, and co-owner of Millburn and Mott Furniture until 1979. For the past five years he had owned Prompt Printing and recently was employed at Starnes TV.

He was elected to the Grinnell City Council in 1968 and served four years. He was past president of the Lions Club and a member of the Toastmasters Club. He was also a 28-year member of Hermon Masonic Lodge, was past master of the lodge in 1976, and was a member of O.E.S. No. 47 and past patron in 1969.

Survivors include his wife, Dolores; three children, Lt. Cdr. Rex Mott of the U.S. Navy in Newport, R.I.; Linda Hasley of Montezuma and Virginia Mott of Des Moines; and five grandchildren. He was preceded in death by his parents and two half-brothers, Fred and Harry Mott.
