Nelson McCabe Dies At Nursing Home

Nelson D. McCabe, 82, of 1102 Summer St., passed away Friday forenoon at the Lone Elm Nursing Home, following an extended illness.

The son of Phillip and Elvina Wainscott McCabe, Mr. McCabe was born on Nov. 17, 1886 at Upper Lake, Calif. He received his education in the schools of that community and in 1908 he enlisted in the U. S. Army and served a period of six years as a sergeant with Troop K of the 11th Regiment Cavalry.

On Feb. 17, 1913, he married Gwen Reese at Des Moines. Following their marriage, the couple lived in Madrid, Iowa until 1960, when they moved to Grinnell to be with their only daughter Mrs. Donald Killion.

Survivors include his daughter, Mrs. Donald (Gwen) Killion of Grinnell; two grandchildren, Mrs. Jerry Lippincott of Enid, Okla. and Gary Killion of Grinnell; three great grandchildren, Michael and Dana Lippincott and Robbie Killion, and one sister, Mrs. Charlotte Snyder of Sacramento, Calif.

Mr. McCabe was preceded in death by his parents, his wife Gwen on Sept. 5, 1962 and seven brothers and sisters.
