Keith McCammant, 59, of Grinnell died Tuesday, Sept. 8, at the Veterans Administration Medical Center in Iowa City.

A memorial service was conducted Friday at Ivy Hill Cemetery, Malcom, with the Rev. John Epperson of the Grinnell Christian Church officiating. Pallbearers were Ronnie Crady, Jack Douglas, Bill Hamel, Chuck Reed, Jim Reimers and Buzz Smith.

The son of Virgil and Opal Mal-
latt McCammant, he was born May
18, 1939, on the family farm near
Ewart. He received his education in
the Malcom School District and
was a veteran of the U.S. Navy.

He was employed as a truck
driver and held various construction
jobs. He owned and operated
Grandpa's Furniture Store for sev-
eral years prior to his retirement in
1992. He was a former member of
the Grinnell Eagles Lodge and was
a member of the Eagles tug-of-war
teams in the early 1980s.

nell and Renee Haley of Princevill,
Ill.; two brothers, Kenneth of
Mitchellville and Richard of Grin-
nell; and six grandchildren.

He was preceded in death by his
parents and his best friend, Tom
