Mrs. McCarel Dies Tuesday

Mrs. Grace McCarel, 74, died Tuesday afternoon, March 14, at Community Hospital following two weeks of hospitalization.

She was born near Hubbard, Ia., on Sept. 14, 1892, to Parker and Mattie Hodgson Harvey. Mrs. McCarel attended schools near her home and was graduated from Hubbard High School in 1911. After attending Grinnell College for two years, she received her B.A. degree from Iowa State Teachers College at Cedar Falls. She was married to Glen H. McCarel on July 26, 1920, at LeGrand, Iowa.

Mr. and Mrs. McCarel made their home in Newburg, Iowa, for several years where Mr. McCarel operated the Newburg Elevator Company. Mrs. McCarel taught elementary and junior high schools in Havocock, Maxwell, LeGrand and Newburg for 20 years.

Mrs. McCarel was a member of the United Church of Christ (Congregational) in Grinnell and Chapter 113, P.E.O. She was a Past Worthy Matron of Onyx Chapter No. 250 of the Order of Eastern Star in Gilman, Iowa. She received an honorary post from the Grand Chapter of the Eastern Star for serving as Iowa's Grand Representative to Kansas.

The McCarels have been residents of Grinnell for 25 years where Mr. McCarel was in the real estate business.

She is survived by her husband, Glenn, of 1130 East St.; a sister, Mrs. E. B. (Estelle) Clemens, of Spencer, Iowa; a niece, Mrs. Wesley (Kathryn) Jones of Ontario, Oregon; and a nephew, Bruce Harvey of Placerville, Calif.

She was preceded in death by her parents; a brother, Harold Harvey, former superintendent of the Des Moines Public School system; and a sister, Mrs. Glenn (Hazel) Mills.

Funeral services for Mrs. McCarel will be at 1:30 p.m. Friday, March 17, at Smith Funeral Home with the Rev. Newell E. Davis, minister of the United Church of Christ (Congregational), officiating.
