Allen, son of Isaac and Annie McCartney, was born in Clinton county, Ohio, on June 19, 1864, and passed away at his home near Barnes City Feb. 13, 1960 at 95 years of age.

When he was about five years of age, he came with his parents to a farm south of Barnes City, where he attended rural school and grew to manhood.

He was united in marriage with Matilda Morrow on June 11, 1890. They made their home in Mahaska and Poweshiek counties for over 61 years. To this union, three children were born, one son died in childhood and one son, Conn, passed away in January 1954. Mrs. McCartney passed away in October 1951.

In May, 1956, he was united in marriage with Mattie Minner and they have made their home on the farm south of Barnes City.

He is survived by his wife, a daughter, Millie Gorsuch, four grandchildren, five great grandchildren and three great great grandchildren; other relatives and many friends.

Funeral services were held at 2 p.m. Tuesday, Feb. 16 at the Steffy Funeral Home, conducted by Rev. G.R. Dieken. Mrs. Keith Stahl, accompanied by Louis Gorsuch sang "The Old Rugged Cross" and "Ivory Palaces."
