OBITUARY.

Sadie Agnes McCaw.

Miss Sadie Agnes McCaw, daughter of Mrs. Hugh McCaw, was born Feb. 6, 1890, near Deep River, Ia. There she grew to young womanhood and was highly esteemed by all. She was always pleasant and energetic, skilled in many arts so dear to the heart of a young woman, and always appeared in the best of humor. She united with the Fairview United Presbyterian church some eight years ago. For two years she was in attendance at the State Teachers College at Cedar Falls, Ia. When she went there her church membership was transferred temporarily to that city, and she took great interest in work for Jesus. She was a member of the Y. W. C. A. and found much pleasure in the work of that association.

Her death followed an attack of heart trouble on the evening of Dec. 1, 1916, in Cedar Falls. Two brothers, a sister and a friend were with her constantly until she fell asleep. She was the second of seven children to be called to the eternal home.—Thomas H., a brother, and also her father having preceded her. The remaining children, William J., James E., Albert F., Lewis H. and Mrs. Elizabeth Johnson were all present at the funeral. Besides her brothers and sister, she leaves a broken hearted mother, a large circle of close relatives and other dear friends who mourn their loss and offer their sympathy to the bereaved family.

Following her death there was a short service conducted in Cedar Falls which was largely attended by students and college faculty before the body was taken to her home northwest of Deep River.

Services were held at the home Sunday at 1:30 p. m., conducted by Rev. W. R. Lawrence of Grinnell. The body was laid to rest in Mount Zion cemetery.
