## Former Resident Mabel McClintic Dies In East

In failing health since last November, Mrs. Mabel McClintic, 54, wife of Ralph P. McClintic, died Tuesday morning at the United States Naval Hospital at Charleston, S. C. She was a former Grinnell resident.

Funeral services will be held at 2 p.m. Saturday at the Smith Funeral Home with the Rev. J. E. Kingsley of the First Baptist church officiating. Burial will be in the Bethel cemetery.

Music at the services will be provided by Mrs. Rhee Auman. Pallbearers will be Harry Ashling, William Ashling, Norman Hanover, Charles Taylor, George Taylor and Gaylon Wunn.

Born June 2, 1905, she was the daughter of William and Nora Swain Taylor and attended the Grinnell public schools. On Feb. 5, 1933, she was married to Ralph P. McClintic of the United States Air Force. They traveled extensively throughout the United States and overseas. Before moving to Charleston about a year ago, they had lived in Biloxi, Miss., and in Cheyenne, Wyo.

She is survived by her husband Ralph; two brothers, Ed Taylor of Grinnell and George Taylor of Des Moines; and one sister, Mrs. Lester (Ellen) Ashling of Gilman.

Preceding her in death were her parents and one brother.
