

Elizabeth McClure Rites Conducted

Funeral services were held at 2 p.m. today (Thursday, July 8) at the Malcom Presbyterian church for Mrs. Elizabeth McClure, 88, of Malcom who died Monday afternoon, July 5, at Grinnell General Hospital. She had been hospitalized for three weeks.
