Rule suicide

in death of McCoy girl, 16

Kimberly Ilene McCoy, 16, of Holiday Lake near Brooklyn, died at her home Friday evening. *Jan. 20*

Authorities said death was the result of a self-inflicted .22 cal. gunshot wound to the head.

The body reportedly was discovered by a sister. Miss McCoy was pronounced dead at Grinnell General Hospital.

Funeral services for Miss McCoy were scheduled to be held at the Montour United Methodist Church, with burial at Maple Grove Cemetery, Montour. Friends may call the Mason-Hand Funeral Home in Tama for additional information.

The daughter of Merle and Patricia Simmons McCoy, she was born Sept. 6, 1961, at Marshalltown. She attended South Tama schools, and this year was attending BGM School in the ninth grade. She was a member of the Montour United Methodist Church.

Survivors include her parents; two sisters, Pam of Marshalltown and Susan at the Holiday Lake home; her paternal grandparents, Mr. and Mrs. Dennie McCoy; and two half-brothers, Dave and Steve. She was preceded in death by a step-brother and her maternal grandparents.
