Merlin DeWitt, son of William and Nevada McCullough, was born Cct. 5, 1897 in Ormond, Ill., and departed this life Jan. 28, 1959 at Hollywood Presbyterian Hospital in Los Angeles, Calif. at the age of 61 years.

When still a child they moved to Rayville, Mo., where he was baptised into the Methodist Church. Later they moved to Des Moines where he completed his education at East High School, later attending Drake University.

On Dec. 1, 1928 he was united in marriage to Mildred Evans of Searsboro, Iowa. The past 18 years he was in charge of the rural mail route at Searsboro.

He was a member of the I.O.O.F. Lodge of Scarsboro and the Masonic Lodge of Lynnville.
