Elizabeth McNally was born in Ireland, March 11, 1826 and died in Grinnell, Ia. Aug. 6, 1907. She was married to James McNally, March 6, 1852, in New York City. Three children were born to this union, James of Fort Worth, Texas, Mrs. Louis Stahl, who died in Des Moines 5 years ago, and Mrs. Charles Stahl, who died in Ia. Mr. McNally was a

man of sturdy build, well educated and was respected by all.

She was a devoted member of the Catholic church and a member of the St. Vincent de Paul Society. August 5, a religious mass was sung by Rev. James Curran of Brooklyn, assisted by Miss Mary Moran of Brooklyn, Mrs. Robert Malcom and Mrs. William O'Connell. The floral tributes were many and beautiful, among them a cross and heart from the Astor society of which she had a ways been a member.
