**Prominent Montezuma Man Passed
Away October 14th.**

James McDonald, prominent resident of Montezuma and citizen of the county, passed away at the Mt. Pleasant sanitarium on Saturday, October 14th. Mr. McDonald, who was well past middle age, had been in poor health for almost six years but had only been receiving treatment at the sanitarium for less than two weeks.

The deceased had spent most of life in the county and during his period of activity he was an architect and contractor. He was forced to stop his work six years ago on account of the state of his health.

The body was brought to his home in Montezuma and the funeral services were held at the home Thursday, conducted by the Rev. Mr. Underhill. Interment was made in the Montezuma cemetery.

Mr. McDonald is survived by his wife, a daughter, Miss Hazel McDonald, one brother and two sisters.

Mrs. Van Feltis, formerly a teacher in the Grinnell schools and before her marriage, Miss Florence McDonald, is a niece of the deceased.
