## Terry McDowell Killed In Mishap

Terry Wayne McDowell, 19, of San Francisco, Calif., a former Grinnell resident, was killed Feb. 22 in a one-car accident in San Jose, Calif. He was pronounced dead on arrival at a San Jose hospital.

Terry was a resident of Grinnell from his birth until April, 1963, when he moved with his parents, Mr. and Mrs. Dana M. McDowell, to California.

He attended schools in Grinnell and West Pittsburg, Calif., and spent his last year in San Francisco, Calif. He had been employed as a service station attendant.

Terry was the grandson of Mrs. Ruth Garwood and had visited in Grinnell at Christmas, spending the holidays with his grandmother, relatives and friends.

While living in Grinnell, Terry was an active member of Calvary Baptist church.

Funeral services for Terry McDowell were held on Feb. 26 at the Pittsburg Funeral Chapel with the Rev. Troy Welch, pastor of the Temple Baptist church of that city, officiating. Burial was at Memory Gardens cemetery at Concord, Calif.
