## Funeral Services Held For William McGrory

Funeral services were held at 9 a.m. Thursday, March 19, at St. Bridgets Church in Victor for William Felix McGrory, 72, of Victor who died Tuesday, March 17, from a heart condition.

The Msgr. E. C. Greer officiated at the services. Pallbearers were Daryl Gallagher, John McGrory, Leo Deveraux, John Cahill, George Michalek, Melvin Jack, Clair Simmons and Frank Higdon.

Burial was in Calvary Cemetery in Grinnell.

The son of James and Ella Cahill McGrory, Mr. McGrory was born on a farm south of Chelsea on Aug. 3, 1897. He attended the rural schools near Chelsea and St. Ambrose Academy.

On Jan. 27, 1925, he married Mary Elizabeth Comerford, and to this union four children were born.

Mr. McGrory had been a long time member of the St. Bridgets church of Victor and the Knights of Columbus Lodge. He had made his home east of Victor.

Survivors include four children—Mrs. Raymond (Rose Marie) Foley of Belle Plaine, Mrs. Cyril (Carmella) Gallagher of Grinnell, James McGrory of Victor and Mrs. Lyle (Geraldine) Campbell of Toledo; 26 grandchildren; two sisters—Mrs. Joe (Jennie) Hannon of Williamsburg and Mrs. Ray (Nell) O'Brien of Parnell; one brother, James McGrory of Chelsea, and many other relatives and friends.
