Roseanna Montague was born near Londonderry, Donegal County, Ireland, May 10, 1826, and passed away February 14, 1904. At the age of two years she was partially orphaned by losing her mother and when she had attained the age of twelve years her father also passed away leaving her in care of very dear friends and a good christian family with whom she and her father had made their home after her mother's death, and with whom she remained until her marriage with Thomas McKane in 1845.
