

J. M. McKARAHAN DEAD

One Of Grinnell's Substantial Business Men Passed Away
Wednesday

HEALTH HAD BEEN FAILING
FOR SEVERAL YEARS.

Came To Grinnell Eleven Years Ago—
Was A Successful And Helpful
Citizen.

J. M. McKarahan, one of Grinnell's good citizens, passed away at 2 o'clock Wednesday afternoon at his home on Main street. His health had been gradually declining for a number of years. Funeral services were held at 2 o'clock Wednesday afternoon at the residence.

Mr. McKarahan has since his coming to Grinnell for eleven years, having arrived in Grinnell, Iowa, in 1919, at which time he took possession of the hardware store, valued up to a few hundred dollars, owned by the family name of Edward Dean McKarahan. Failing health caused his resignation from active business when he sold the store to Dorrell & Forehand and it was the plan of the family to have him live at a home that he would be better there. Mr. McKarahan was 65 years of age.

Mr. McKarahan was a Christian business man. His active business career extended over 35 years. He was honest, progressive and reliable. He made a reputation for square dealing and all around integrity that is a pleasant memory for those he leaves behind. He was devoted to his home and family, absorbed in his business, but interested in all that pertained to the best interests of Grinnell. His home was shared not only by his family but by all those with whom he has come in contact in a business and social way during the years of residence here.
