

Rites held for Mr. McKeag

Marlin L. McKeag, 43, of Oskaloosa, formerly of Grinnell, was killed Friday in a plane crash at the Oskaloosa Municipal Airport.

Funeral services were conducted at 1:30 p.m. Tuesday at the Watts Funeral Home in Montezuma, with burial at Pleasant Township Cemetery near Ewart.

A native of Montezuma, Mr. McKeag lived most of his life in Grinnell, moving to Oskaloosa in 1981. He was employed as a pilot for the Mahaska Bottling Co.

A four-year Navy veteran, he formerly worked for Midwest

Aviation in Ottumwa. He was a member of the Aircraft Owners and Pilots Association.
