Mrs. John C. McMeekin Of Ewart Passes

The funeral services of Mrs. John C. McMeekin were held from the home April 28, and she was laid to rest in Pleasant Hill cemetery at Ewart.

Isabella McMeekin, daughter of Andrew and Mary E. McMeekin, was born in Rock Island, Ill., Sept. 9, 1856, and passed away at her home in Ewart April 26 at the age of 75 years, 7 months and 17 days. She became a member of the United Presbyterian church of Ewart in the early 90's.

She was married to John C. McMeekin of Ewart Sept. 10, 1884, and was the mother of four children. Three passed away in infancy: Joseph A., a baby, and Mary Ann, who passed away June 30, 1893, aged 1 year, 2 months and 2 days. She is survived by one son, James Francis, who with his family in Ewart was always in her mind and it was a great pleasure to have them with her. Her father and mother and three brothers, Francis, John and James, preceded her in death.

She leaves to mourn her loss her husband, John C. McMeekin, a son James F. and wife, four grandchildren, Leona M., Thelma M., James Clell and Almae M.
