## **Last Services for Fred B. Neighbors Sunday Afternoon**

Funeral services for Fred B. Neighbors were held from the Methodist church Sunday afternoon, conducted by the pastor, Rev. Chas. H. Rowe. Pall bearers were Nigel Anderson, Wm. Anderson, Allen Crooks, Chas. Pickering, Lou Ent and Horace Ent.

Appropriate music was rendered by a quartet. Burial was in Hawthorn cemetery.

Mr. Neighbors died Friday evening after a protracted illness. He would have been 53 years old if he had lived until his next birthday, June 7.

Fred B., son of William and Mary Neighbors, was born June 2, 1886 near Unionville, Mo. He grew to manhood farming near Unionville. On September 12, 1912 he was united in marriage with Mrs. Fern Smith and to this union two children were born, Albert Lee and Alice Marie, both of Grinnell. On January 19, 1924, he joined with the Methodist church at Unionville.

His life came to a peaceful close Friday evening, April 7, at his home in Grinnell. 1939
